This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five by and between Selah Ellsworth and Sally his Wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Newson of the said County and State of the other part. Whereas that the said John Ellsworth and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Six dollars, twelve and a half cents to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Newson at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and they the said Selah Ellsworth and Sally his Wife, have granted, bargained, sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell alien and confirm unto him the said Thomas Newson his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton of Situated on the North side of the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company, beginning at the intersection of the north line of the land of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road Company with the line of Jeptha Holt's land & the lands lately of Allison Doyle and running Northerly on the line of Jeptha Holt's land and the line of the land lately of Allison Doyle Four hundred & forty two feet to a Post Oak the corner of the lands of Jeptha Holt, Thomas Newson, Selah Ellsworth and the lands lately of Allison Doyle, then running Eastwardly on the line of Selah Ellsworth's land & the land lately of Allison Doyle, one hundred and forty seven feet to a Red Oak, thence running four hundred and thirty three feet to a corner Post in the North line of the land of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road company, which corner Post is distant one hundred and eighty feet from the intersection of all mentioned, thence running (Westwardly on the North line of the land of the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company, one hundred and eighty feet to the intersection of the North line of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road company with the line of the land of Jeptha Holt and the land lately of Allison Doyle containing one acre and three rods. To have & to hold the said granted Land and premises, with all profits to primitive conveniences and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Thomas Newson his heirs and assigns forever, to him and his only son for use and behoef. And we the said Selah Ellsworth and Sally his Wife and for ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree that we Selah Ellsworth and Sally his Wife will warrant and forever defend the just right and title of the said tract to
