This Indenture made and entered into this twenty fourth day of September  
in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Ann Nines of the  
Town of Smithfield in the County of Isle of Wight and State of Virginia of the one  
part, and William S. Mills of the County and State aforesaid of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Ann Nines for and in consideration of the sum of two hun-  
dred dollars to her in hand paid by the said William S. Mills at and before the  
making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, she  
the said Ann Nines hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents with  
great bargain, sells and conveys unto the said William S. Mills his heirs and assigns,  
all her right, title, interest claim and demands in and to a certain lot or piece  
of ground situated lying and being in Jerusalem in the County of Bathampton which  
William Nines held & title to by lease for a term of Years, which said lease or title  
of said William Nines was sold at public auction by the Sheriff of the said County  
of Bathampton, and was at which sale purchased by the said Ann Nines. To have  
and to hold the said Ann Nines right title, interest, claim and demands in and  
to the said lot or piece of ground with the buildings and improvements thereon belong-  
ing unto the said William S. Mills his heirs & assigns, to the only proper use & benefit  
of him the said William S. Mills his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Ann Nines  
for herself & her heirs covenants to and with the said William S. Mills to warrant and  
defend the right of title, hereby sold & conveyed, against the claim and demand
