This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day of December in the year 1835
between Charles Fuller of the one part William Blaw of the second & Richard Porter of the third,
of the first of these parties of the County of Southampton Va. and he of the second part of the County
of Dinwiddie, Minors, that whereas the said Charles Fuller is justly indebted to the said
Richd Porter in the sum of forty dollars and fifty cents due by note bearing equal date with
the presents & on ans. the same day of its date, and being desirous to secure the payment there-
of to him the said Richd Porter hath agreed to convey certain property hereinafter mentioned to
the said Wm Blaw for that purpose. Now this Indenture further witnesseth that the said Charles
Fuller for & in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
Blaw, the receipt whereof he the said Fuller doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargain-
ed sold and does by these presents grant bargain & sell to the said Wm Blaw & his
assigns the following property to wit 2 beds and furniture 1's dog. 2 black bottom Chairs, 2
Tables (one walnut & cherry) one cupboard 3 Trunks & 1 chest, in fine all his household & kitchen
furniture. To have and to hold the said property to him the said Wm Blaw & his af-
signs, & the said Fuller doth warrant & defend the title thereof to him the said Blaw &
his assigns. Upon Trust however that if the said Charles Fuller shall well & truly
discharge the said note with all interest which may become due in or before the 25th
Decr 1836 this Indenture to be void & the property herein conveyed to rest again in the
said Fuller. But should the said Fuller fail at the time aforesaid or should the said
Porter conceive himself in danger of suffering at any time between this & the said 25th
Decr 1836 it shall be the duty of the said Blaw at the request of the said Porter
to sell at Public auction the aforesaid property, and out of the proceeds first pay &
recharge the cost attending the execution of this trust then pay off the Bond aforesaid
with the interest which may have accrued thereon & the overplus pay to the
said Charles Fuller or his order. In Witness whereof the parties have hereunto set
