This Indenture made and entered into this fifteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five between Catharine Weston and Rebecca Rose of the County of Southampton of the first part and Patrick Rose of the County aforesaid of the second part. Whereas the said Catharine Weston and Rebecca Rose are the only heirs at Law of a certain Mills Benson late of the County of Southampton & lately deceased intestate and the said Mills Benson in his lifetime having executed a will how his property & estate should be disposed of and so being unwilling to carry into effect the wishes of said intestate and for the further consideration of the love and affection which we have to our Son and Heir, Patrick Rose do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Patrick Rose, that he the said Patrick Rose shall keep and retain quiet use and possession of two boxes which were given to him by the said Mills Benson in his life time, one of said Boxes executed by Patrick Dels and Benjamin Griffin, the other by John Boykin and Elias Summerell (both making about the sum of five hundred dollars) and are due and payable to said Mills Benson and in further consideration of the premises give, grant alien release and convey unto the said Patrick Rose his heirs or assigns all the right title interest claim and demand which we may or do now have whether in possession, reversion or remainder in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land of which the said Mills Benson did seized and possessed lying in the County of Southampton and known by the name of Larises Tree containing about one hundred and twenty acres, saving and reserving about twelve or fifteen acres of said Larises tract which is to be cut off and annexed to the home tract next to said home tract for the purpose of equal distribution, the right and title of which said boxes and Land aforesaid we hereby warrant and assign unto the said Patrick Rose his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of us, our heirs executors, administrators or assigns or all and every person or persons whatever claiming by or through us. And it is further agreed and covenanted between the said Rebecca Rose and Catharine Weston and they do hereby covenant and agree that the funeral expenses and debts of the said Mills Benson shall be paid and satisfied out of the money found in the house of said Benson after his death and should it not be sufficient to discharge the same they bind themselves jointly to contribute for the discharge of such debt of expenses, and should there be more than sufficient to pay and satisfy the same then it is agreed between the parties last aforesaid that the said Catharine Weston shall have and enjoy the said surplus to her only proper use and behoof as well as the remaining moiety of the Land of which the said Mills Benson did seized and possessed consisting of the home tract and the small portion cut off from the Davis tract, and the said Rebecca Rose for and in consideration of the promises as well as for the further consideration of the natural love and affection which she has for her sister Catharine hath and doth by these presents give, grant alien release and convey unto the said Catharine Weston all right title claim interest and demands which she the said Rebecca Rose hath in and to the money aforesaid after the payment of the debts of expenses of said intestate as well as the same aforesaid within in possession reversion or remainder together with all the residue of so Bensons estate not herein named to the same real or personal to have and
