Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Griffen, Saml. B. Jones, Cassius Batts, Robert Richs, Jesse Parker, Patrick Lokes, Lewis N. Branch, Clements Rechele in his and jointly bound unto Littleton H. Hazewell Esqr, Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty thousand dollars, to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the said Commonwealth; for the payment whereof well and truly to be made, we and ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally, jointly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 18 day January 1836.

This condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above bound Benjamin Griffen, is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the ____ day of December last past: of therefore the said Benjamin Griffen shall well and truly collect all moneys and accounts for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed, and also all fines forfeitures and moneys accruing or becoming due the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth for the time being, for the use of the Commonwealth, in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of Public taxes and shall in all other things, truly and faithfully execute the office of Sheriff during his continuance
