This Indenture made and executed the 19th day of October in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Samuel R. Gardner of the
County of Southampton in the State of New York of the one part and Assay Cope of the
County of Nassau and State aforesaid of the other part: Whereas by an inter-
citing were made and entered in the County Court of Southampton at the June
term 1836 in a cause lately depending in the said Court between Solomon Daugh-
erty of others plaintiffs, and Nelson B. Gardner defendant: it was agreed and
ordered that Samuel R. Gardner after giving thirty days notice of the time and
place of sale, should expose to public auction upon a credit of nine months the
tract or parcels of land which lies in the aforesaid County, and which was held
as dower in the lands of Matthew Gardner deceased by Mary Gardner and which
lands are divided by the lands of Harry Cope, Edward Crumpler, Nelson B. Gardner
and the heirs of Uriah T. Gardner, except so much as may be necessary to pay
and discharge the proper and necessary expenses of said suit, and after deducting
the same from the amount to take bonds for the balance thereof with good secu-
rity payable to the parties, as by said decree directed. And whereas in pursuance
of said decree the said Samuel R. Gardner Commissioner as aforesaid on the 25th
day of July 1835, in the premises, expose to publick sale to the highest bidder, the
said tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County aforesaid adjoining the lands
of Harry Cope, Edward Crumpler, Nelson B. Gardner and the heirs of Uriah T. Gardner
notice of the time and place of sale having been given thirty days previous thereto
in conformity to said decree when Harry Cope became the purchaser of the said tract
or parcel of land for the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars. And whereas by
a final decree pronounced by the said Court of Southampton at the October term 1835 upon
a report returned and filed in the said cause at the August term 1835 to which no
objection was filed; it was further ordered and agreed that the said Commissioner do
reprint in the case made to the purchaser deed without warranty. This Indenture
therefore further witnesseth that the said Samuel R. Gardner Commissioner as aforesaid
doth for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as of the sum of one dol-
lar to him in hand paid by the said Harry Cope the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold, aliened and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant, bargain, sell, alien and confirm unto the said Harry Cope his heirs and assigns
the said tract or parcel of land before mentioned and aforesaid, and which was held at
