Johnson and Anna his Wife for an in consideration of the sum of three hundred
and ninety dollars and twenty five cents lawful money of Virginia to him in hand
paid by the said Josiah Vicks at or before the sealing and delivery of these pre
sents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, both granted bargained and sold, aliened
enjoyed and confirmed and by these presents with good bargain and will alien enjoy and
confirm unto him the said Josiah Vicks his heirs and assigns forever one certain lot or
piece of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and par
ish of Saint Lakes containing ninety acres be the same more or less and bounded as
follows on the north by the Lands of John Thomas, on the West by the Lands of James
Vicks on the south by the lands of Richard Jordan, and on the east by the Lands
Samuel Story, together with all right, title, claim interest or demand of in and to the
said lot or piece of Land and premises thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. He
have and to hold the aforesaid lot or piece of Land and premises with all and singular
its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Josiah Vicks his heirs and assigns
forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Josiah Vicks his
heirs and assigns: and the said Mills Johnson and Anna his Wife, for themselves
their heirs Executors, assigns & assigns with hereby covenant and agree to and with the said
Josiah Vicks his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that they will by these
presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid lot or piece
of Land hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of all of all and every per
