This Indenture made this first day of January One thousand eight hundred and thirty-six between Richard Branch of the one part and Mordecai Broadshaw of the other part. Witnesseth that the sd. Richard Branch for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars unto him in hand paid by the sd. Mordecai Broadshaw, the receipt whereof the sd. Richard Branch doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained and sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents as grant bargain and sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the sd. Mordecai Broadshaw, all that tract or parcel of Land, which he the sd. Branch bought of Samuel Joiner, called Doyle tract lying and being situate in the County of Southampton and on the north side of the Road leading from Jerusalem to the Black water Bridge and bounded as follows, beginning at the Road at a pine in Abidgton Broadshaw's line thence a line of marked trees in the sd. Broadshaw's to a pine a corner tree in sd. Broadshaw's line which stands in a small branch, down sd. branch to Frank's Branch, up Frank's branch to the mossy branch to a pine a corner in The Drawings of the heirs of Jesse Vick thence said Vick's line of marked trees to a split oak a corner in the Land formerly belonged to Rebecca Joiner thence a line of marked trees to the road down sd. road to the first station, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining with the reversions and reversion remainders & remainders and profits and every part and parcel thereof, to have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances unto the sd. Mordecai Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever of the said Richard Branch for himself his heirs and assigns, the said bargained
