This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day of December in the year
of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty four, between Lewis Norrell & Temperance his wife of
the first part and Lewis Norrell Junr. of the other part all of the County of Southampton and
State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Lewis Norrell and Temperance his Wife for & in con-
sideration of the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars current money of Virginia, to them the
said Lewis Norrell and Wife by the said Lewis Norrell Junr. in hand paid the receipt whereof the
said Lewis Norrell and Wife do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold & conveyed
and by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Lewis Norrell Junr. his
heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County aforesaid contain-
ing seven hundred and thirty nine acres, be the same more or less and bounded as follows, to
wit beginning at the intersection of Crossfords Road & Thomas Swamp thence around the
said swamp the various courses thereof to Reddy's Pond and the intersection of that of
the school House branch thence around that branch the various courses thereof to a
lightwood stump a corner of Amos Stephenson thence along a line of marked trees N. 38°
W. 64 poles thence N. 25° W. 53 poles thence N. 47° W. 53 poles thence N. 46° N. 68 poles
to the Road, thence the same course N. 46° N. 14 poles to a pine a corner of Amos Ste-
phenson thence N. 43° E. 26 poles thence N. 58° E. 22 poles to a pine standing on the
side of Barrows Road, thence along the said Road N. 49° E. 23 poles thence along the said
Crossfords Road N. 33° E. 210 poles to the beginning. To have and to hold the said
tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to him the said Lewis
Norrell Junr. his heirs & assigns, to the only proper use & behoof of him the said
Lewis Norrell Junr. his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Lewis Norrell &
Temperance his Wife for themselves, their heirs assigns do hereby covenant and agree
to and with the said Lewis Norrell Junr. his heirs and assigns that the said Lewis
Norrell and Temperance his Wife & their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with
its appurtenances unto him the said Lewis Norrell Junr. his heirs & assigns
against them the said Lewis Norrell & Wife their heirs and assigns, and against all
