This Indenture made and entered into on the 19th day of December In the year Norrell Wife of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty-five between Lewis Norrell and Temperance Norrell his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Josiah Norrell of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Lewis Norrell and Temperance his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Josiah Norrell at or before the executing and delivery of these presents. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents as and each of them with grant bargain sell alien infeoff and confirm unto him the said Josiah Norrell his heirs and assigns forever the following tracts or parcels of Land and premises, situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes containing by late surveys one thousand four hundred and six acres (be the same more or less) the said tract or parcels of Land bounded as follows. to wit the tract whereon the said Josiah Norrell now resides containing 1152 1/2 acres (more or less) and bounded as follows, to wit: beginning at a red oak standing near Boon's Run a corner for the upper land of Billy Williams, in John Norrell's line, thence along the above line N 76° W 24 poles to a pine thence N 68 1/2° W. 15 poles to a dead pine thence S 90° W 88 1/2 poles to a post, thence S 58° West 83 1/2 poles to a pine a corner of the said above land also a new corner for said Lewis Norrell, thence along said Lewis Norrell's land S 70° E. 58 1/2 poles to a new oak a corner for Elizabeth Chitty thence along her line S 70°
