This Indenture made and entered into on the 19th day of December In the year
Norrell & wife of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty five between Lewis Norrell and Temperance Norrell
to his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Josiah
Norrell of the same County and State of the other part. It is further that the said
Lewis Norrell and Temperance his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two
thousand dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the said Josiah Norrell at or before the sealing, and delivery of these presents.
The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents as and each of these doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him
the said Josiah Norrell his heirs and assigns forever the following tract or parcels of
land and premises, situate beginning, and being in the aforesaid County of Southham-
pton and Parish of St. Luke containing by late survey one thousand four hundred and
six acres (be the same more or less) the said tract or parcels of land bounded as follow.
to wit the tract whereon the said Josiah Norrell now resides containing 1153 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres (more
or less) and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a red oak standing near Boons Road
a corner for the upper land of Silly Williams, in John Norrells line, thence along the west
line N 70° E 24 poles to a pine thence N 08 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 15 poles to a tree pine thence N 08 $\frac{1}{2}$ E
1188 ft poles to a post thence N 08 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a pine a corner of the said upper
land also a new corner for said Lewis Norrell thence along said Lewis Norrells land N
E. C. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a rear oak a corner for Elizabeth Shelly thence along her line N 70° E
