

This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of December 1835 between Elizabeth Britt of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and Harrison Parker of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witness that the said Elizabeth Britt for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged she the said Elizabeth Britt have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Harrison Parker his heirs and assigns two tracts or parcels of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton one tract known as the Pine Grove tract containing by estimation Fifty acres be the same more or less and adjoining the land of the heirs of Henry Baranor decd. Henning T. Smith, Harrison Cobb and others. The other tract known by the name of Britt's old place containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less. situated on the Notoway River, and adjoining the lands of the heirs of Mary Baranor decd. Harrison Cobb decd. and others, to with all right title interest claim or demand of in and to the said two Tracts or parcels of Land and premises together with its appurtenances thereto belonging on in any wise appurtening and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said two Tracts of parcels of Land and premises with all appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtening and every part & parcel thereof unto him the said Harrison Parker his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of him the said Elizabeth Britt for herself, for his heirs, Executors and assigns do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Harrison Parker his heirs Executors and assigns that she will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the said two Tracts or parcels of Land hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed, against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
