Witnesseth that the said Francis Rockelle for and in consideration of Six hundred and sixty six dollars to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained sold and confirmed, and do by these presents, grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Edward Beaton his heirs and assigns forever, one certain piece lot or parcel of Land and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the west side of Sinner Cough and bounded on the west side by Rockells bridge Road and being a part of the lot of Land which was allotted to the sd. Francis Rockelle in the division of the Land belonging to the Estate of Lawrence Cook decd., the boundaries whereof will more fully appear Having reference to report of Commissioners appointed to make the same and which is of record in the County Court of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and eleven acres more or less. To have and to hold the said lot parcel and granted land and premises above mentioned unto the said Edward Beaton his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Francis Rockelle for herself her heirs and assigns doth further agree to and with the said Edward Beaton his heirs yet that they will forever save and spare the right title and interest of the said premises before mentioned unto him the said Edward Beaton his heirs and assigns forever against the claims and demands of the said Francis Rockelle, her heirs and assigns forever, or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming by, from or under her.
