Given under our hands and seals this 29. day of Decr. 1835.

This Indenture made this 18th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six between Ella Butts of the County of Southampton of the one part, and Barham Hoorn of the same County of the other part, both of the State of Virginia. Whereas that the said Ella Butts for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollar, to her in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the said Barham Hoorn his heirs, executors, admors. and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation twenty acres, be the same more or less bounded as follows that is to say, beginning at a pine near the Road leading from the Bridge across the Raccoon Swamp below Dicks Mill on towards Butts bridge, thence to a Locust a corner in Barham Hoorn's line; thence to a pine a corner in the same, thence to the Road aforesaid to a pine another corner in said Hoorn's line, thence bounded by the said Road to the beginning; it being the place whereon John Butts used formerly lived. Together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Barham Hoorn his heirs executors admors and assigns forever free from the claims of her the said Ella Butts her heirs &c. and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
