This Indenture made this Sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between William Bryant of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the one part and Orman M. Bryant of said County
and State, son of William Bryant of the other part. Whereas that the said William
Bryant, a well for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he hath
in behalf unto the said Orman M. Bryant his son, hath given granted and conveyed and
conveyed unto the said Orman M. Bryant a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the
County of Southampton, containing by estimation two hundred & sixty one acres and a
half bounded as follows, beginning at a pine standing in the state line a corner between
Cawin G. Hart and William Bryant, thence along the state 250 poles to a pine
a corner of John Darden's thence N. 14 E. 22 poles thence N. 54 W. 60 poles thence
north 196 poles to a Hickory a corner between Cawin G. Hart and William Bryant
standing near the Road thence along the said Road S. 56 W. 180 poles to a small red
ash bush a corner between Cawin G. Hart and William thence S. 11 W. 40 poles
over a small branch, thence along the run of said branch to the first station. To
gether with all the houses, out houses, garrets, orchards, ways waters, and all property
taco whatsoever belonging or in any wise pertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land.
To have and hold the said tract of land unto him the said Orman M. Bryant his heirs
and assigns. And the said William Bryant for himself his heirs and assigns doth con-
tract and agree to and with the said Orman M. Bryant that the above granted prop-
erty is free and clear of all charges and incumbrances whatever shall well and de-
