This Indenture made this seventeenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between William Bryant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Orman M. Bryant of said County and State, son of William Bryant of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Bryant, as well for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he hath and beareth unto the said Orman M. Bryant his son; hath given granted conveyed and confirmed, unto the said Orman M. Bryant a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation two hundred & sixty one acres and as half, bounded as follows, beginning at a pine standing in the state line a corner between Calvin E. Hart and William Bryant, thence along the state 250 poles to a pine a corner of Jethu Lardens thence N. 1/4 E. 22 poles thence N. 5 1/4 N. 68 poles thence with 176 poles to a Hickory a corner between Calvin E. Hart and William Bryant thence near the Road thence along the said Road S. 56 1/4 N. 181 poles to a small red oak bush a corner between Calvin E. Hart and William thence S. 11 1/4 N. 51 poles over a small branch, thence along the run of said branch to the first station. Together with all the houses, out houses, gardens, orchards, ways, waters, and all privileges whatsoever, belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcels of Land. So have and hold the said tract of land unto him the said Orman M. Bryant his heirs and assigns. And the said William Bryant for himself, his heirs and assigns doth warrant and agree to and with the said Orman M. Bryant that the above granted premises is free and clear of all charges and incumbrances whatever, shall well and lawfully and forever defend by these presents.
