This Indenture made the 20th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five by and between Willis M Lawrence and Anne his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Samuel and Ann his baron of the County of Isle of Wight and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas it is agreed between the said Willis M Lawrence and Anne his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Lawson at or before the recording and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they presents us and each of them with a grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Lawson his heirs and assigns forever here part of a tract or parcel of land called Townhouse lying in the aforesaid Co. of Southampton containing by estimation three acres, bounded north east by Blackwater River and west by Jacob J. Williams together with all and singular the hereditaments or remainders or remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the same part of the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Samuel Lawson his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Willis M Lawrence and Anne his wife for themselves and their heirs hath granted and sold there out of the premises and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold. To the said Samuel Lawson his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of them the said Willis M Lawrence and Anne or either of them or heirs forever.
