

This Indenture made the 20th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty six between Jeremiah Cobb of the one part and Gray S. Jenkins of the other part (all of the County of Southampton). Witnesseth, that the said Jeremiah Cobb in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Gray S. Jenkins before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Gray S. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever, a part of a certain tract or parcel of land which the said Jeremiah Cobb bought of Edwin Vick & Margaret his Wife, and bounded as follows to wit, all the land lying between the Casunkas of Village fork of the Mill pond, formerly brick laves, and now John Vick's and supposed to contain about one hundred and ninety acres be the same more or less, reference being had to the said deed from Vick to Cobb, the boundaries well fully appear, together with all the houses, barns, gardens, profits and emoluments, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land, and the reversions and reversions, remainder and remainders, yearly & other rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof, to have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements, hereditaments, and all and singular parts and parcels thereof, and every of the rights and appurtenances unto the said Gray S. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Gray S. Jenkins, his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Jeremiah Cobb for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land, with all and singular the houses and appurtenances before mentioned, unto the said Gray S. Jenkins his heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claims of him the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs, and all and of every person or person whatsoever, shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. This Indenture made the 6th day of June in the year eighteen hundred and thirty six between Nelson Jones and Margaret his wife of the County of Isle of Wight and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Peltier of the County of Surry and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Nelson Jones and Margaret his wife in consideration of sixty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Peltier, at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Peltier his heirs and assigns forever a certain Mill in the County of Southampton commonly called L. Ck's
