This Indenture made this 25th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ McLennan the Eighteen hundred & thirty six, between Stanley McLennan and his wife Mary McLennan of the one part and Eliska Whitfield of the other part all of the County of Southampton & parish of Nettorney Kingsfeste that the said Stanley McLennan & his wife Mary in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Eliska Whitfield at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Eliska Whitfield his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred & sixty acres be the same, more or less, and bounded by the lands of John Harris, Miles Griffin the poor house tract, Mellers house heirs & Ole Joiner, formerly the Howell land, reference to former deeds being had well more fully appear, together with all & singular the houses out houses, outhouses, buildings yards gardens ways water & watercourses commodities, advantages and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land commodities, advantages and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining, to the same or any part or parcel thereof. He have unto to hold the said land with all and singular the premises hereto before mentioned or intended to be sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Eliska Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Eliska Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever and the said Stanley McLennan and his wife Mary for themselves heirs, the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Eliska Whitfield his heirs free from the claim or claims of them the said Stanley McLennan and his wife Mary or either of them, their, of either of their heirs, and of all and every other persons whatsoever, shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents.
