This Indenture made this 29th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six between James Clayton of the County of Southampton of the one part, and William Rayford of the said County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said James Clayton for and in consideration of the sum of sixty-eight dollars, good & lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Rayford, the receipt whereof I do here acknowledge & the said James Clayton hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents, with grant bargain and sell unto the said William Rayford his heirs and assigns forever all my right title and interest in a tract or parcel of land and promises situated lying and being in the County of Southampton formerly the property of William Hummell dead and conveyed by the deeds of Parrell Grand William Rayford and James Clayton together with all houses and thereto belonging, To have and to hold the said land and promises to him and his heirs forever and the said James Clayton for himself, his heirs & assigns by these presents covenant, and grant to and with the said William Rayford that he the said James Clayton, against all person claiming by or through him the aforesaid land, well forever warrant and defend.
