This Indenture made this 29. day of December AD. 1835 between John Barkham and
 his wife Louisa M. his wife of the County of Southampton of State of Virginia of the one part and
 George Williams of said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
 John Barkham and Louisa M. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hun-
 dred and ten dollars to them in hand paid at the executing and delivery of these pre-
 sents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these pre-
 sents do bargain and sell unto the said George Williams his heirs and assigns forever a
 certain parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton of State of Vir-
 ginia containing by a late survey seventy and a half acres and bounded as follows beginning
 at a black gum standing in a small branch in said John Barkham's line thence along
 his line down the run of said branch 38 poles to a post standing at the intersec-
 tion of said small branch and another small branch thence up the run of the other
 branch 40 poles to a pine a new corner of said John Barkham in Carl's line thence
 S 88° N. 66 poles to a pine a corner bet said Carl and George Williams' line thence a-
 long said Williams' line S 55° N. 17 poles to a pine thence S 56° N. 24 poles
 to a pine a corner for James Taylor thence along his line S 17° E. 13 poles to a pine
 thence S 5° N. 15 poles to a Red oak thence South 23½ poles to a red oak thence
