conveyed and sold, and by these presents do and each of them (the said William T. Blow
and Lucy his Wife) doth grant bargain sell alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Lewis
Morrell, his heirs and assigns forever two certain tracts or parcels of land and premises (to-
wit) lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parishes of Saint Luke's,
