more or less, being the Land the said Bryant purchased of Thomas New
and bounded by the lands of Mike Ellis, Jerry Taylor, and Temperance Hines. To have
the said Jesse Little his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Bailey Bryant for himself, his heirs and
administrators hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Jesse Little his heirs
and administrators that he the said Bailey Bryant well warrant and defend
the title to the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and promises unto him the said Jesse Little
his heirs and assigns against the claim and demand of him the said Bailey Bryant
and of all and every other person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof the said Bailey
Bryant hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of February one thousand
eight hundred and thirty six between Bailey Bryant of the first part, William R. Edwards
of the second part and Charlotte Bryant wife of said Bailey Bryant of the 3rd part all
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witness that whereas the said Bailey
Bryant and wife the said Charlotte as the legal representatives of Amos Nicholson and of the
County of Sussex and State aforesaid have for certain purposes heretofore to mention,
sold as the representatives of said Nicholson at Public Auction the following slaves to wit,
Harry, Solomon, Mina - belonging to the said est. and following negroes of the said Amos
Nicholson to wit, Daniel, Henry, Albert, Jacob, Jack & Polly; and whereas the said
Bailey became the legal purchaser, and bona fide owner of the said Slaves, and whereas the
said Bailey Bryant being anxious and desirous to secure to the said Charlotte his wife
the use of the negroes as well as the absolute property. Now therefore for and in
consideration of the Love and affection which the said Bailey Bryant bears to his wife the
said Charlotte and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Bailey Bryant of the first part doth
hereby bargain sell alien in feoff and confirm unto William R. Edwards of the third
part all the above named negroes to him, his heirs exec. administrators for in trust over-
to keep and employ the said Negroes to the special use and benefit of the said
Charlotte. In witness whereof the said William R. Edwards shall sell and convey
the said negroes to the said Charlotte to her heirs and assigns for or if the said Char-
lotte shall die first and before the said Bailey Bryant making or conveying her interest
by will or otherwise to any third person or persons whatsoever, that then the said
William R. Edwards shall sell and convey the said negroes to such grantee or grantees, exec.
