This Indenture made this 24th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty-six between Nathaniel M. Osborne and Mary A. his wife of
 the County of Cumberland and State of Virginia of the one part and Griffon Orgain of the coun-
 ty of Surry and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel M. Osborne
 and Mary A. his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of thousand four hundred dollars current
 Money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Griffon Orgain the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold, aliened and confirmed, and by these
 presents as grant bargain and sell, alien release and confirm unto him the said Griffon
 Orgain his heirs and assigns all their right, title, interest claim or demand of, in and to men-
 tioned ninth part of all the lands and plantations in the County of Southampton and State of Vir-
 ginia which bequeathed by the Will and Testament of William Allen son of Surry County to his
 nephew and niece and which one ninth part of the said lands and plantations descends to the
 said Mary A. Osborne as one of the nieces of the said Wm. Allen; and which was conveyed by
 the said Osborne and Wife to the said Orgain and by the said Orgain conveyed back to the
 said Nathaniel M. Osborne, by deed bearing date in the year 1826 which deed we duly re-
 corded in the books office of the County of Southampton and to which for greater certainty, as
 well as to the will of the said William Allen reference is hereby directed to be made to-
 gether with all buildings, ways, water courses, fishings, privileges, advantages, emoluments hereditaments
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the said ninth part of the said lands and plantations belonging
 or in any wise appertaining as it lies undivided in the County of Southampton aforesaid. We
 have and to hold the said ninth part or portion of the said lands and plantations with all and sin-
 gular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part
 and parcel thereof unto the said Griffon Orgain his heirs and assigns forever. And the said
