

This Indenture made this 13th day of December in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Lewis N. Branch Mathew Harris & Eli Baker
Commissioners appointed by order of the County Court of Southampton made at either
end one thousand eighteen hundred and thirty five to make sale of the Land wherein
Elis Barnes died seized & present of the one part and Miles Scarborough of the County
of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum
of forty-three dollars current money of Virginia to the said Commissioners in hand paid
and made to be paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the no-
tice whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Lewis N. Branch Mathew Harris
& Eli Baker Commissioners as aforesaid, have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Miles Scarborough his heirs and af-
fors, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County Coun-
ty of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and eighty acres, be the same
more or less, being the same tract of land wherein Polly Barnes deceased formerly lived
and dwelt by the Lands of Russell Barrett, John Hines and others with all and
singular the premises and all the appurtenances thereto belonging; to have and to hold
the said tract of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said
Miles Scarborough his heirs and assigns forever; the said Lewis N. Branch Mathew Harris
and Eli Baker Commissioners as aforesaid so for the heirs of the said Polly Barnes
and all and every other person or persons claiming by from or under them by virtue
of the devise aforesaid the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular
the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Miles Scarborough his
heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of the heirs of the said Polly Barnes
or either of them, they or either of their heirs and of all and every person claiming by from
or under the said Polly Barnes, warrant and forces defend (by virtue of these parts derived from
the law aforesaid. Notwithstanding the said Lewis N. Branch Mathew Harris & Eli Baker Com-
missioner as aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year
last above written
