 sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
 bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 alien conveyed and confirm unto the said Henry Blow his heirs and assigns forever the
 tract of Land sold by the sd. Commissioners lying on the Nollaway River, which Margaret
