This Indenture made and entered into this twenty-first day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, between Williams Vicki of the one
part and Fidelity J. Mahone of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia, Winchester. That the said Williams Vicki for and in consideration of the sum of
two thousand dollars, lawful money of this Commonwealth, to him in hand paid by the
said Fidelity J. Mahone at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath bargained and sold, and by these presents hath bargained
and sold unto the said Fidelity J. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or por-
tion of land situate lying being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Abbeville
containing by a recent survey twenty three acres, to it the same, more or less, and bounded as
follows, to wit, beginning at the South end of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road at
the point where the County Road leading from Northhead to Jerusalem crossing the said
Rail Road thence along the said County Road South, twenty one acres West, seventy four
and a half poles, to an Elm, thence north seventy-three degrees east forty & 2/3 poles,
