Witnesseth that I the said Tilghman Jelks for and in consideration of the sum of ten hundred dollars to me in hand paid, by the said Barkham Moore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said Tilghman Jelks have bargained, granted and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Barkham Moore to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on the North side of the Raccoon Swamp containing Fifty acres be the same more or less (more or less) as follows beginning at the main Run of the Raccoon Swamp at the bridge thence up Peter's road to a White oak at corner of George Blous line, thence along Blous line to an Elm in deep branch at corner of the sd. Branch thence across the sd. deep branch to the run of Raccoon Swamp thence down the run of Raccoon Swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant unto the said Barkham Moore to be held by him his heirs or assigns forever. And I the said Tilghman Jelks for myself and my heirs and all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming under them shall and lawfully warrant and defend the said presents.
