This Indenture made this second day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty six between Thomas B. Norrell, William Bryant and Davis Bryant Commissioners appointed by a Act of the County Court of Southampton to sell the Lands of which Benjamin Barnes was possessed and which said lands lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and sold on the 31st day of March last by the aforesaid Commissioners in pursuance of the Act aforesaid, and Jacob Barnes became the purchaser for the sum of eight hundred and forty dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the Commissioners aforesaid, in consideration of whom aforesaid, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever the aforesaid tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and fifteen acres, to be at the same more or less.
