 part & John Wick of the same County and parish of the other part: Witnesseth the said Sal-
 ly Swanner (f. or) for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty good and lawful money of
 Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Sally Swanner both acknowledge herself fully and com-
 pletely satisfied and paid hath granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents hath granted,
 bargained and sold unto the said John Wick one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situated
 and lying in the County aforesaid containing by Estimation sixty acres be the same more or less
 and bounded as follows — together with all the houses, out houses, Cisterns, buildings, yards, gar-
 dens, orchards, Meads, water ways &c. whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and
 to hold the said Land to him the said John Wick to him and his heirs forever and the
 said Sally Swanner (f. or) for herself her heirs with warrant and forever defend by these pre-
 sents any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof. In Witness
