This Indenture made this 19th day of Decr. in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Sterling Hedge & Mary his Wife of the County of South-
ampton of State of Virginia of the one part and James Drewry of the said County & State
of Virginia of the one part and James Drewry of the said County of State of the other part. We
testify that for and in consideration of the sum of forty eight dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby
fully acknowledged by the said Sterling and Mary his Wife hath granted, bargained and by their
presente do grant, bargain sell & confirm unto the said Drewry and his heirs forever, one
certain piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the said City and on the south side of
the Road leading from Burfield to Jerusalem containing by a recent survey Twelve acres to be
more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a Locust tree on the said Road at a
corner to it, thence to a new chopped line adjoining the sd Hedge & 35 1/2 ft 15 ft
poles to a shrub oak a corner to John Shephard along his line N 85° W 13 poles N
85° W 8 poles to a branch a corner to the sd. Drewry, along his line S 89° W 12
poles N 85° W 7 poles N 13° E 33 1/2 poles to the Road and along the said Road as
it meanders to the beginning with all the benefits and improvements thereto belonging to the
said James Drewry his heirs & assigns forever, which said land & the said Hedge as her-
rent and forever defend the right & title to the said Drewry his heirs & assigns forever a-
gainst the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever. The Notary Public and
the said Sterling & Mary his Wife hath unto set our hands and affixed our seals this day
and year above written.
