Now therefore know all men by these presents that, I the said Priscilla Grimes for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to me in hand paid & for other good causes & considerations, the receipt of which, twenty dollars I do hereby acknowledge, have bargained & sold unto Jeremiah Drow of the County of Northampton & State of North Carolina and as hereby bargain & sell unto the said Jeremiah Drow all my right, title and interest in & to the above mentioned property, to have & to hold the said property to him the said Drow his heirs & assigns for ever. And I the said Priscilla Grimes for the considerations above mentioned do hereby warrant & defend my right title & interest to him the said Drow from the claim of all other persons, so far as my own act is concerned.
