This Indenture made the 22nd day of March in the year 1836 between Benjamin
 B. Griffin of the one part and Shagars Laine of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said
 Benjamin B. Griffin in consideration of \$300 dollars of lawful money of the commonwealth
 to him in hand paid by the said Shagars Laine at or before the sealing and delivering
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold, and
 a certain tract of land containing one hundred Acres more or less in the County of
 Southampton and bounded as follows, commencing at a pole bridge across the main road
 that leads from Jerusalem to Smithfield, near the corner of Joseph Millers Lane thence al-
 long the road to a White oak corner tree joining Henry Lenoys road thence along a line
 of pines trees to a sweet gum corner tree, thence along to a White oak corner tree joining Mi-
 chael Millers line & a branch thence up the branch to the beginning to the aforesaid pole
 bridge together with all (the singular Houses, buildings, yards, orchards, lands, tenements,
 meadows, pastures, feedings, commons, woods, underwoods, ways, waters, water, houses, fishing, pri-
 vileges, profits, commodities, advantages, emoluments, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to
 the said tract of Land belonging or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed or accepted,
 or taken or known as part, parcel or member thereof or as belonging to the same or any
 part thereof, and the reversion and reversions, yearly and other rents, issues, and profits there-
 of of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with
 the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other premises herein before mentioned
 or intimated to be bargained and sold and every part and piece thereof with every
 of his rights, members and appurtenances unto the said Shagars Laine his heirs and assigns
 forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the Shagars Laine his heirs and
 assigns forever. And the said Benjamin B. Griffin for himself and his heirs the said
 Laine his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Benjamin B.
 Griffin or his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall, will, and do
 demand and forever assign by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Benjamin

 ten.
