and eighty seven dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Dunn before the  
writing and delivery of these presents, they the said Rollings and Wife have granted, bar-  
guined and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, and sell unto the said Thomas  
Dunn certain tract or parcel of land lying and being, situate in the County of South-  
ampton containing one hundred and twenty nine acres, be the same more or less, and  
bound as described in a deed for the same from Benjamin Lewis to the said Rollings  
and of record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County to which reference is here  
made. To have and to hold the said tract of land and its appurtenances to him  
the said Thomas Dunn and his heirs and assigns forever, And the said Samuel Rollings for  
himself and his heirs covenants with the said Thomas Dunn of his heirs and assigns that  
he shall have quiet possession of the said tract of land and appurtenances, and that he  
will warrant and defend to him a good title to the same against the claim of all per-
