This Indenture made and entered into this day of May in the year of our Lord  
 eight hundred and thirty six between Henry Bishop of the County of Southampton and  
 State of Virginia of the one part and Davis Bryant of the same County and State  
 of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Bishop for and in consideration of  
 the sum of one hundred and seventy one dollars current money of this Commonwealth to  
 him in hand paid by the said Davis Bryant at or before the executing and delivery  
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold  
 aliened, released and confirmed and by these presents with grant, bargain, sell, alien,  
 release, confess and conform unto him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever the  
 following Lands lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of  
 Saint Lukes to wit one tract or parcel of Land containing by a late Survey seventeen  
 acres bounded as follows. Vizt. beginning at a black oak formerly a corner for the  
 lower Land of Priscilla Maget aec<sup>d</sup> now a corner for said Davis Bryant & said  
 Henry Bishop's line thence along said Davis Bryant's line South 36 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles then  
 N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 21 $\frac{1}{4}$  poles thence S. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 58 $\frac{1}{4}$  poles to a corner near the path, thence N.  
 83 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 61 poles to a dead White oak on said path a new corner for said Davis Bryant  
 and said Henry Bishop, thence N. 42 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 130 poles to the first station also  
 two fifts of the undivided lower Land of Priscilla Maget aec<sup>d</sup> containing by survey re-  
 cently seven acres of the said two fifts of the said lower lands being the same that  
 said Henry Bishop purchased of Joseph Greary and Martha his wife, and John  
 D Maget and Martha his wife for the boundaries of said lower Land in force  
 may be had to the Report of the Commissioners who were appointed by a Decree  
 of the County Court of Southampton to divide the lands of Samuel Maget aec<sup>d</sup> It  
 is agreed to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land containing seventeen  
 acres also two fifts of the lower of Priscilla Maget aec<sup>d</sup> with all and singular  
 their appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Davis  
 Bryant his heirs and assigns forever (to use for the only proper use and behoof of  
 him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever) Also the said Henry  
 Bishop for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators with covenant and agree to  
 and with the said Davis Bryant his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns that he will  
 by these presents warrant and forgive release the right and title of the aforesaid tract  
 or parcel of Land and two fifts of the aforesaid lower Land, and every part  
 or parcel thereof against the claim or demands of all and every person or persons  
 whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Henry Bishop hath hereunto set his hand  
 and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
