This Indenture made and entered into this day of May in the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred and thirty six between Henry Bishop of the County of Southampton and of the State of Virginia of the one part and Davis Bryant of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Henry Bishop for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy one dollars current money of this Commonwealth of him in hand paid by the said Davis Bryant at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, confirmed and by these presents with grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, confirm unto him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever, the following Lands lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes to wit: one tract or parcel of Land containing by a late survey seventeen acres bounded as follows, Vizt. Beginning at a black oak, formerly a corner for the lower Land of Priscilla Magel decd. now a corner for said Davis Bryant is said Henry Bishop's line, thence along said Davis Bryant's line South $58\frac{1}{4}$ poles, thence N. 85° E. $21\frac{1}{4}$ poles thence S. 1° M. $58\frac{1}{4}$ poles to a corner near the path, thence N. $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 64 poles to a dead White oak on said path a new corner for said Davis Bryant and said Henry Bishop, thence N. $42\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ M. 138 poles to the first Station, the two fifths of the undivided lower Land of Priscilla Magel decd. containing by survey seventy seven acres (the said two fifths of the said lower Land being the same that said Henry Bishop purchased of Joseph Greary and Martha his Wife, and John D. Magel and Martha his wife for the boundaries of said lower Land in force may be had to the Report of the Commissioners who were appointed by a Deed of the County Court of Southampton to divide the Land of Samuel Magel decd. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land, containing seventeen acres also two fifths of the lower of Priscilla Magel decd. with all and singular their appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever (to have for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Henry Bishop for himself, his heirs Executors and administrators with consent and agree to and with the said Davis Bryant his heirs, executors, admin. and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and two fifths of the aforesaid lower Land, and every part or parcel thereof against the claim or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever. On Witness whereof the said Henry Bishop hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
