And moreover that the said Joseph T. Slade do warrant and forever defende against any person or persons claiming or asserting any part or parcel of the aforesaid Lands or Lands it being in the County of Southampton mentioned, with all its appertinences tenements &c. This Indenture made this 18th day of May one thousand eight hundred & thirty six between Merit Robertson Drake of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia one of the one part and Matthew Drake of the County aforesaid of the other part sheweth that the said Merit Robertson Drake for and in consideration of the just and full sum of thirty dollars in hand paid by the said Matthew Drake the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Merit Robertson Drake have given granted bargain and sold unto the said Mott Drake and to his heirs for ever all the right title claim or demand which he has or ever will have in any part or parcel thereof of his Mother's Land at the death of Thomas C. Brock or any other way and do acres which will be his at the death of Benjamin Minter conformable to the said Benjamin Minter during his life then to Merit Robertson Drake, conformable to Minter his life by Thos. C. Brock and Sally his Wife too.
