This Indenture made the tenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thou-
 sand eight hundred and thirty-six between Harrison Holt and Polly his wife of the County
 to Southampton in the State of Virg^a of the one part and Harrison Parker of the County and
 State afores^d of the other part: Witnesseth that the ss. Harrison Holt and Polly his wife
 for and in consideration of the sum of Nine dollars and fifty cents to them in hand paid
 by the said Harrison Parker at and before the executing and delivery of these presents (the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said Harrison Holt and Polly his wife have
 granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do, and each of them doth grant, bargain
 and sell unto the said Harrison Parker his heirs and assigns a certain piece or parcel of
 Land, lying and being in the County afores^d and marked and bounded as follows: Begin-
 ning at a Spire at the side of the Road leading from South Quay to the Ferry at Morris,
 thence along the road S. 55° E. 42 poles to the road leading to South Quay, or the road
 now called the new road, thence along the new road first S. 16° E. 40 poles, thence S. 21° E.
 16 poles to a oak at the road side, thence S. 65° W. 13 poles to a small post oak, thence
 N. 16° W. 54 poles to a Spire, thence N. 35° W. 28 poles to the beginning containing more or less,
 the same more or less together with all and singular the premises and reversions, remainder and remain-
 ers, yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and
 to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned
 or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right
 members and appurtenances unto the said Harrison Parker his heirs and assigns forever: Inas-
 much the said Harrison Holt and Polly his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or par-
 cel of Land with all and singular the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
 Harrison Parker his heirs & assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said Har-
 son Holt & Polly his wife or either of them, their or either of their heirs and of all and
 every other person or persons whatsoever, shall well and so warrant and forever defend by their
 presents. In Witness whereof the said Harrison Holt & Polly his wife have hereunto set
 their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
