This Indenture made and entered into the 23rd of June 1806 between Stephen
Mordaugh, Trustee for Mordaugh of the one part and John M. Gurley of the other part, both of the County of
Southampton, Whereas by an order of the County Court of Southampton, pronounced Sept 21 1799
in a case therein depending between the creditors of George L. Gurley, Plaintiff & Geo. L. Gurley
defendant it was decreed that Stephen Mordaugh be appointed trustee to sell a certain tract
of Land conveyed in a deed of Trust from George L. Gurley to William R. Allison and for the
benefit of Jno M. Gurley & others, after giving legal notice of time and place of sale, and
whereas in pursuance of said decree the said Stephen Mordaugh on the 16th day of Novem-
ber 1805 did advertise to sale the aforesaid Tract or parcel of Land, in the said trust men-
tioned containing one hundred & thirty nine & 1/2 acres siting his dividend interest mention-
ed in the aforesaid deed in trust executed to Allison and, as aforesaid, the boundaries of
said Land will fully appear by reference to the commissioner's report who divides the Land of
J^ol. Richelle for and Whereas at the sale so made John M. Gurley became the purchaser of
the said Land being the highest bidder, therefor at the sum of Fifty dollars. This Inden-
ture therefore Witnesseth that the said Stephen Mordaugh in consideration of the sum of Fifty
dollars to him in hand paid by the said John M. Gurley before the sealing and delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold,
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John M. Gurley his heirs
and assigns the tract of Land above referred to. To have and to hold the said tract or
parcel of Land, with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Jno M.
Gurley his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Stephen Mordaugh for himself his heirs
executors and assigns, hereby covenant to and with the said John M. Gurley, his heirs and af-
signs against the claim of him the said Stephen Mordaugh, his heirs executors & assigns with
warrant & against the right title and interest in and to the said tract or parcel of Land
against the claim or claims of all and every persons unto the said Jno M. Gurley his heirs
or assigns forever (that is such title and interest as is vest in me as trustee) Given over
my hand and seal the day & date above written
