This Indenture made this 31. day of May one thousand eight hundred and thirty six between Mary R. Wick of the first part, and of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia and Gilbert W. Wick of the second part, of the same County. In Witness that the said Mary R. Wick for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to her in hand paid by the said Gilbert W. Wick at or before the making or delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Mary R. Wick doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied and paid, hath granted bargained, sold release and convey unto the said Gilbert W. Wick one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by a late survey sixty eight acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows to wit, on the north west by the Road leading to Blacks Water Bridge, thence bounded by Robert Wicks Subor Lane then by the Land of James Wick, now Gilbert W. Wick and the Land of the said Gilbert W. Wick: And the said Mary R. Wick for herself doth warrant the right title and claim and interest from her or any other person claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof unto the said Gilbert W. Wick to him and his heirs forever. In Witness whereof the said Mary R. Wick hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal this day and year first above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of April 1833 between Elijah Scarborough, Joel Holt & Mary Battle of the first part, of former Dow of the second part all of the County Northampton of state of North Carolina. In Witness that the said Elijah Scarborough, Joel Holt & Mary Battle hath this day for and in consideration of the sum of ninety dollars to them in hand paid by him the said former Dow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained & sold and by these presents a grant, bargain & sell unto him the said former Dow all that right title & interest which we one each of us have in and to the following property which was bequeathed by Howell Scarborough dec. of the County of Northampton and state of Virginia unto his wife Sarah Scarborough for and during her natural life, to wit one negro man Joe, negro woman Edy & girl daughter as well also as our interest in the stock of all kinds, plantation utensils &c. &c. as well as the land unto the said Sarah Scarborough unto him the said former Dow his heirs & assigns forever, and we the said Elijah Scarborough, Joel Holt & Mary Battle for ourselves our heirs & assigns warrant and defend a just and indisputable right and title of the same after the death of the said Sarah Scarborough against all and every person lawfully claiming the said property or any part thereof.
