partly indebted to the said Mills C. Lawrence in the sum of sixty dollars and ninety cents
as by bond bearing date the 18th day of July 1836 which debt with legal interest thereon
the said William T. Blow is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture witnesseth that
for and in consideration of the premises, and also for the further consideration of one dollar to
the said William T. Blow in hand paid by the said Jesse Dray at and before the executing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William T. Blow hath
given granted bargained, sold aliened, conveyed, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm to the said Jesse Dray his heirs
and assigns forever 1 small cow, 1 Bay horse, 1 small horse, black cow, one yearling cow and yearling
bull, black cattle, 20 sheep including 1 Boar 1 sow and six sows and 15 pigs 1 carry all
and harness one best and two pair of horse Mules, 2 carry-log carts, 3 Bar shaw Bayons 3
pair of trousers 10 blue hose, 1 blanket, 1 pair wings, 8 sewing Need 1 good bed
1 Brimstone and all my proportion of crop of corn, bottom land and garden and fodder
for the present year, 1 small bell, 3 feather beds and furniture, 1 dictionary, 1 Mahogany table, 1 pair
with one clock, 6 Windsor chairs, 5 shuck bottom seats, one good saw all my house hold and kitchen
