This Indenture made and executed this fifteenth day of July in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six between James Harrison of the first
 part Samuel B. Woodard of the second part and Jesse Dreyer of the third part who is
 lawfully chosen as trustee, of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia: Witnesseth that whereas the said James Harrison is indebted to the said Samuel
 B. Woodard by bond bearing date the 17th day of February 1836 for the sum of twenty
 five dollars and the said Samuel B. Woodard being bound as his surety, to a bond
 executed to Benjamin Ellis for four dollars and two other bonds executed to said Ellis
 by James Harrison and Nancy Highough for the sum of four dollars and fifty cents and
 the other for the sum of eight dollars and a bond executed by the same to Samuel
 Ellis for ten dollars and one other bond executed to the same for fourteen dollars and
 twenty five cents and one assumed to Samuel Dreyer for the sum of seven dollars and
 twenty five cents the sales of said bonds and appurtenances is not recalled and the
 said Samuel B. Woodard having become responsible for the payment of the said several
