Witnesseth that the said Crastus Fleming is justly indebted to the said Clements Rockhills in the
sum of two hundred and twenty seven dollars to be paid on the 1st day of August next
as by bond bearing date on the fifteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred & thirty
six more fully appears which debt with the legal interest thereon according the said
Crastus Fleming is willing and desirous to secure: now this Indenture Witnesseth that for
and in consideration of a certain bag Horse and also for the further consideration of one
dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Crastus Fleming in hand paid by the
said Jas. Naget at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Crastus Fleming hath given, granted, bar-
gained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released, and confirmed and by these presents doth give,
grant, bargain, sell alien convey release and conform to the said James Naget their heirs
and assigns forever a certain Bay Horse and all the estate right title and interest
of the said Crastus Fleming in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby grant-
ed certain Bay Horse. To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be gran-
ted certain Bay Horse unto the said James Naget his heirs Executors and assigns
forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Jas. Naget his heirs Executors
and assigns forever: and the said Crastus Fleming for himself his heirs Executors
and assigns forever, in manner, and form following that is to say, that the said Crastus
Fleming his Executors and administrators, the aforesaid certain Bay Horse, unto the said James
