This Indenture made and entered into this nineteenth day of November, one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty four, between John B. Mason and Mary Ann his
 wife of the first part, and Joel Harris of the second part, Witnesseth, that the
 said John B. Mason and Wife, for and in consideration of the sum of three thou-
 sand five hundred dollars to them secured to be paid before the sealing and ex-
 ecution of these presents, which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and
 conveyed, by bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Joel Harris, that tract or par-
 cel of land situate, lying and being in the County aforesaid whereon John A. Reese
 now resides, and bounded as follows to wit, beginning at a corner of the land be-
 longing to Thomas Applewhite's estate, thence East along the lands of Mrs. Reese
 and others to the Swamp which runs near Peter's Meeting House, thence down the said
 Swamp as it meanders to where it crosses the path leading to the said meeting house
 thence south up the said path, to the public road leading to Jerusalem, thence down
 the said Public Road east, to a new-chopped tree at the corner of the fence on the
 south side of the said Road, thence South a straight line four feet east of the
 fence to the run of the Three Croaks, thence along the main Run of the said Croak
 East to the Lands of Thomas Applewhite's estate, thence along the line of the said Ap-
 plewhite's land North to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract of land
 aforesaid with the appurtenances, to him the said Joel Harris, his heirs and assigns
 forever. And the said Mason and Wife for themselves and their heirs covenant with
 the said Joel Harris his heirs and assigns, that they will warrant and defend to
 him and them or good title to the land in the bounds aforesaid with the appurten-
 ances and quiet possession thereof from and after the first day of January next. In witness
