This Indenture made this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, between John Holleman & Sally his Wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Puffin Blart of the other part: Witnesseth that the said John Holleman & Sally his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Puffin Blart at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Holleman & Sally his Wife, have bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Puffin Blart his heirs and assigns the tract of land that formerly belonged to John Broder, containing ninety acres, be the same more or less, bounded on the North by Lightwood Swamp on the West by the land belonging to Drury Branch, on the Southwest, South & East by the land belonging to Puffin Blart, together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the reversion & reversions, remainders and remainders, greatly & otherwise of profits thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments, and all and singular, unto the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and conveyed and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Puffin Blart, his heirs and assigns for ever. And the said John Holleman & Sally his Wife, for themselves & their heirs, the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances, before mentioned unto the said Puffin Blart, his
