third part, whereas the said William B. Stutcliffe is justly indebted to the said Josiah
Manny in the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars with interest & cost, which may become
thereon, due by a bond executed to Josiah Manny, bearing date fifteenth March 1836
for the payment of which the said Josiah Manny stands bound as bail, as more fully
appears, & the said Stutcliffe being willing & desirous to save and secure the said
Manny from loss or harm: Now this Indenture witnesseth that for & in consideration of
the premises & also for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar, good
& lawful money of Va. to the said Stutcliffe in hand paid by the said Henry
Pittway the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, at once before the entering & sub-
scribing of these presents— he the said Stutcliffe hath given, granted bargained and
sold, aliened &c. and by these presents doth give, grant alien release &c. release &
confirm to the said Henry Pittway his heirs & assigns forever, the following property
(to wit.) Three single gigs, to of them topped, two pair giga wheels, two double giga
carriage part of single giga, one steel mare, saddle & bridle &c. together with
& every article belonging to, or appertaining to his branch of business with all
the appurtenances thereto belonging to have & to hold the said hereby granted or
conveyed property by or unto the said Henry Pittway his heirs &c. forever.
