This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between Thomas C. Jones of the first part, John M. Gurley of the second part, and Nathan Parsons surviving partner of Seth R. Strong & Co. and also as the Executor of Seth R. Strong, deceased of the third part: Whereas the said Thomas C. Jones is justly indebted to the said Nathan Parsons surviving partner of Seth R. Strong & Co. by bond bearing equal date with these presents for the sum of Seven hundred and fifty-five dollars and fifty cents, and also as bond executed to the said Nathan Parsons Executor of Seth R. Strong, deceased bearing equal date with these presents, for the sum of Two hundred and four dollars and sixteen cents which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing, the said Thomas C. Jones is willing and desirous to secure: Now this indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises, and also for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia, to the said Thomas C. Jones in hand paid by the said John M. Gurley at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Thomas C. Jones hath given, granted, conveyed, sold, aliened, infeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant bargain and sell, alien, infeoff, release and confirm to the said John M. Gurley his heirs and assigns forever, all that Tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Washington, on the North side of Potomac River, and bounded by the lands of James Scott, Charles Butts and others containing one hundred and sixty acres, to the same more fully, also the following slaves to wit, Brown and Duncan together with the following personal property, to wit, 1 Bannocks and Hams 7 Beds & furniture; with all and singular the appurtenances to the said Tract or parcel of Land (belonging) or in any wise apper-
