

This Indenture made and sealed this 15th day of August in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six between Joseph Denow
 of the one part and Eli Davis of the other part, all of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Joseph Denow for an^{re} in consideration of the sum of six hundred and seventy four dollars current money of Virginia
 paid to him by the said Eli Davis in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,^{on}
 Augt 22/1836, the said Joseph Denow hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed^{are} by
 these presents with grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Eli Davis his heirs
 and assigns, a certain tract plantation or parcel of Land, containing by estimation
 three hundred and twenty two and a half acres, to the same more or less, lying and
 being in the County aforesaid and bounded on the north by the Land belonging
 to the heirs of Peter Pond now Hawthorn Pond, on the South by the Land of
 Joseph Denow and the Mill Pond branch which is the dividing line - bounds on
 the East by the Land of Peter Hooker, and West by the Land of Peter Pura -
 it being the same tract of Land which Henry Denow purchased of Ethelena Reifer
 and devised to Joseph Denow by the said Henry Denow in his last Will and Testament
 in presence being there^{to} had well fully appeared. And the said Joseph Denow do give
 and grant to the said Eli Davis an outlet or passage to the Road over the cause-
 way in the old Mill Pond - the said Denow gave him a passage, the width
 of the cause-way from the bank to the end of said cause-way one from thence thir-
 ty feet wide to the Road, straight with the cause-way. To have and to hold
 the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land, with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to him
 the said Eli Davis his heirs and assigns; to the only proper use and behoof of
 the said Eli Davis, his heirs and assigns, forever: And the said Joseph Denow
 for himself his heirs, executors and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with
 the said Eli Davis his heirs and assigns, that he the said Joseph Denow and his
 heirs, the said tract of Land, with its appurtenances, unto him the said Eli Davis
 his heirs and assigns against him the said Joseph Denow and his heirs, endeavor
 all persons whomsoever, shall and will prove warrant and afford. In witness whereof
 the said Joseph Denow hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal, the 15th
 day of August above written.
