This Indenture made & entered into this 19th day of September 1836 between Richard S. Nicholson of the first part and Sarah J. Felt of the second part. Witnesseth that the sd. R. Nicholson for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the sd. Felt the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, both bargain & sale and by these presents with bargain & sale of convey to the said Felt his heirs & assigns forever all his right title & interest in the slave house of the building on a tract of land in the former Race field near Jerusalem. And by these presents the said Nicholson with warrant and before the same to the sd. Felt for ever.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 19th day of September 1836.
This Indenture was acknowledged by Richard S. Nicholson a party thereto and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the Tenth day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between Harrison Parker and Mariah his Wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, of the one part, and Harrison Cobb of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Harrison Parker and Mariah his Wife, for and in consideration of the sum Two hundred and forty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said Harrison Cobb at and before the executing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said Harrison Parker and Mariah his Wife have granted, bargained and sold & by these presents do, and each of them doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Harrison Cobb his heirs & assigns a certain parcel, or part of a tract or parcel of Land and lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton, called and known by the name of "Bird's Old Place" bounded on the west by Holloway River and the Bridge at, on the East and North by the Land of the said Harrison Parker and Harrison Cobb, and on the South and South by the land of the late Henry Gardner dec. containing two hundred and thirty five or a half acre, be the same more or less; together with all and singular the messuages and messuages, remainder and remainders, yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Harrison Cobb his heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claims of them the said Harrison Parker and Mariah his Wife or either of them, their or either of their heirs, and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall, well and so natural and forever after by their presents. In Witness whereof the said Harrison Parker & Mariah his Wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year as first above written.
