This Indenture made and executed this thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between Joseph Senow of the one part and James Senow of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said Joseph Senow for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars unto him in hand paid by the said James Senow, the receipt whereof the said Joseph Senow doth hereby acknowledge himself fully satisfied and paid and of the same doth by these presents acquit the said James Senow, he the said Joseph Senow hath granted, bargained and sold aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents as grant bargain and sold, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Senow a certain tract, plantation or parcel of land containing by estimation and the de mes, four hundred acres, be the same more or less, lying and being, situate in the County and State aforesaid and bounded as follows (viz) on the North by the Lands of Ed Davis or the Tusquehannah Swamp - on the South by the Lands of John Nick - on the East by Lands of Jesse Crocker, one the West by the Lands of the heirs of Joseph Nick and also John Senow being the remainder, and all the Land which the said Joseph Senow owns in the Berlin tract, which he acquired a title from the death of his father, from his last Will and Testament duly recorded in this County, and being parts of the Lands which Henry Senow purchased of Milledgeford, M'Guffin and the John Johnson tract, with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof. To Have and to hold, the said bargained premises unto the said James Senow his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Joseph Senow for himself his heirs and assigns, the said bargained premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with this appurtenances, clear exempt and secure from all debt or other encumbrances whatsoever unto the said James Senow his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatever now shall and will by these presents forever warranted and defended.
